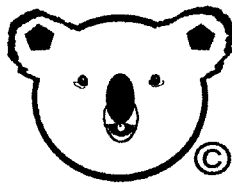

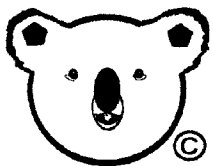
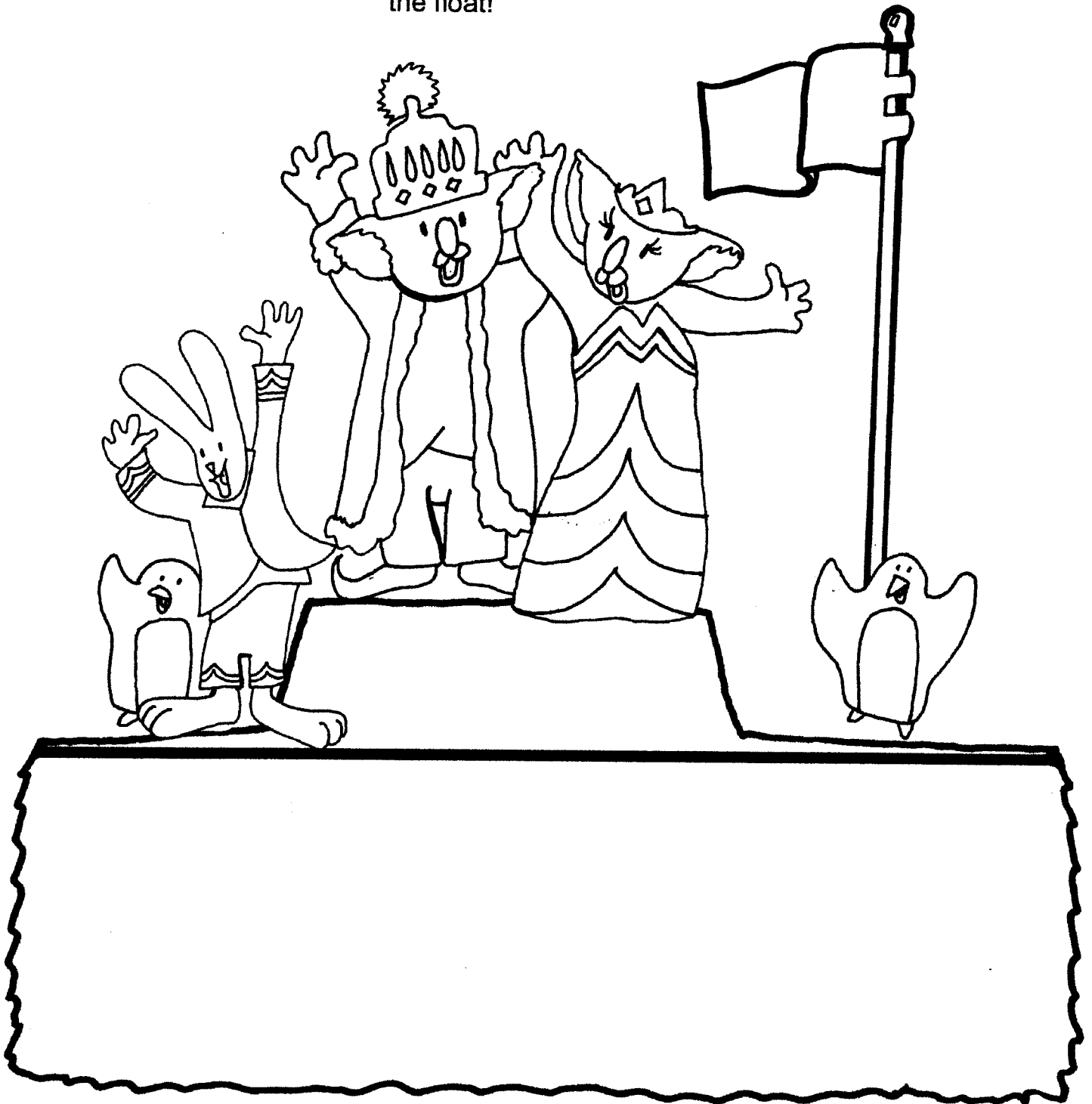

The King and Queen want you to decorate their parade float! Use pencils, crayons, or markers to make patterns for the float!



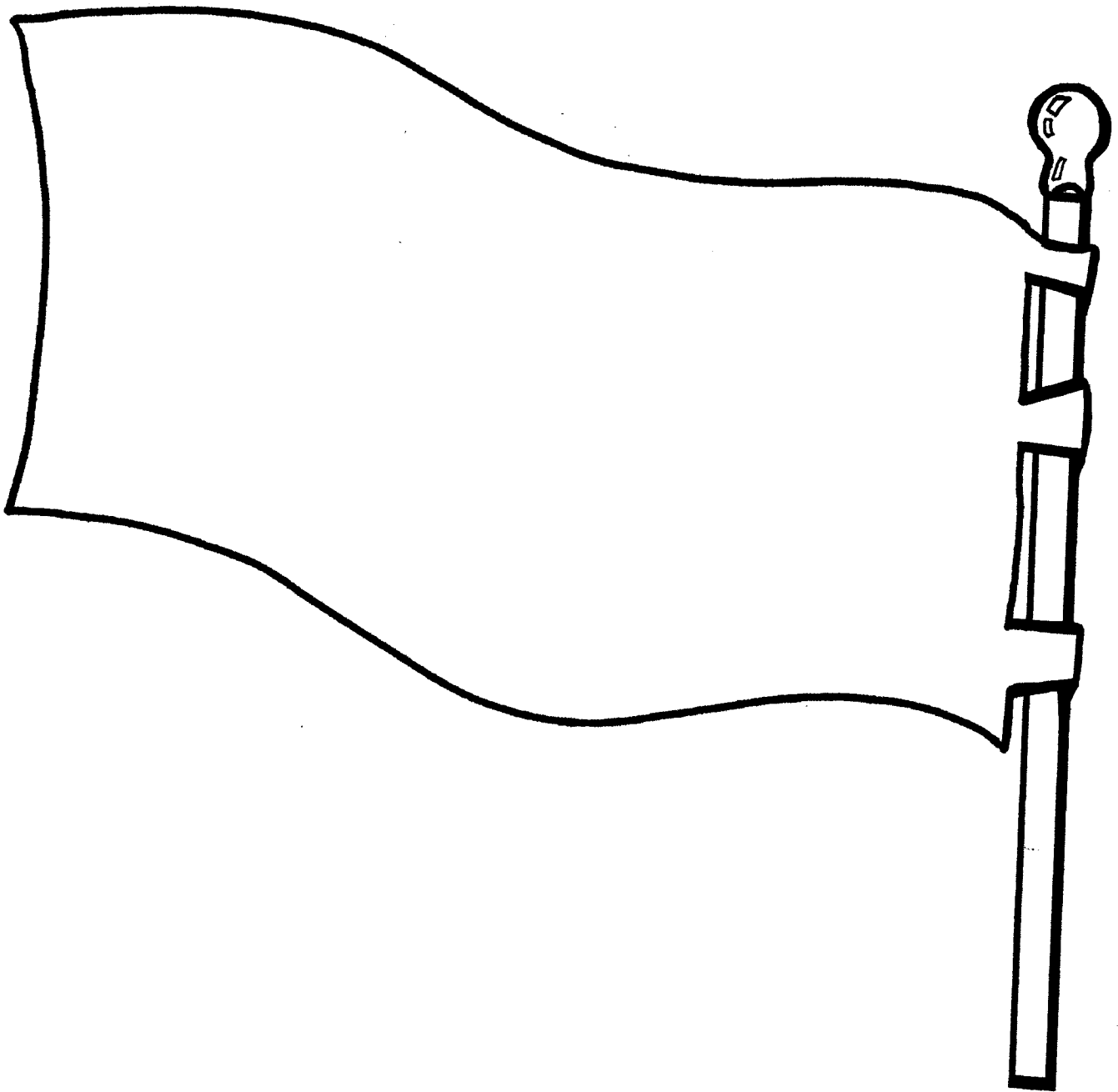

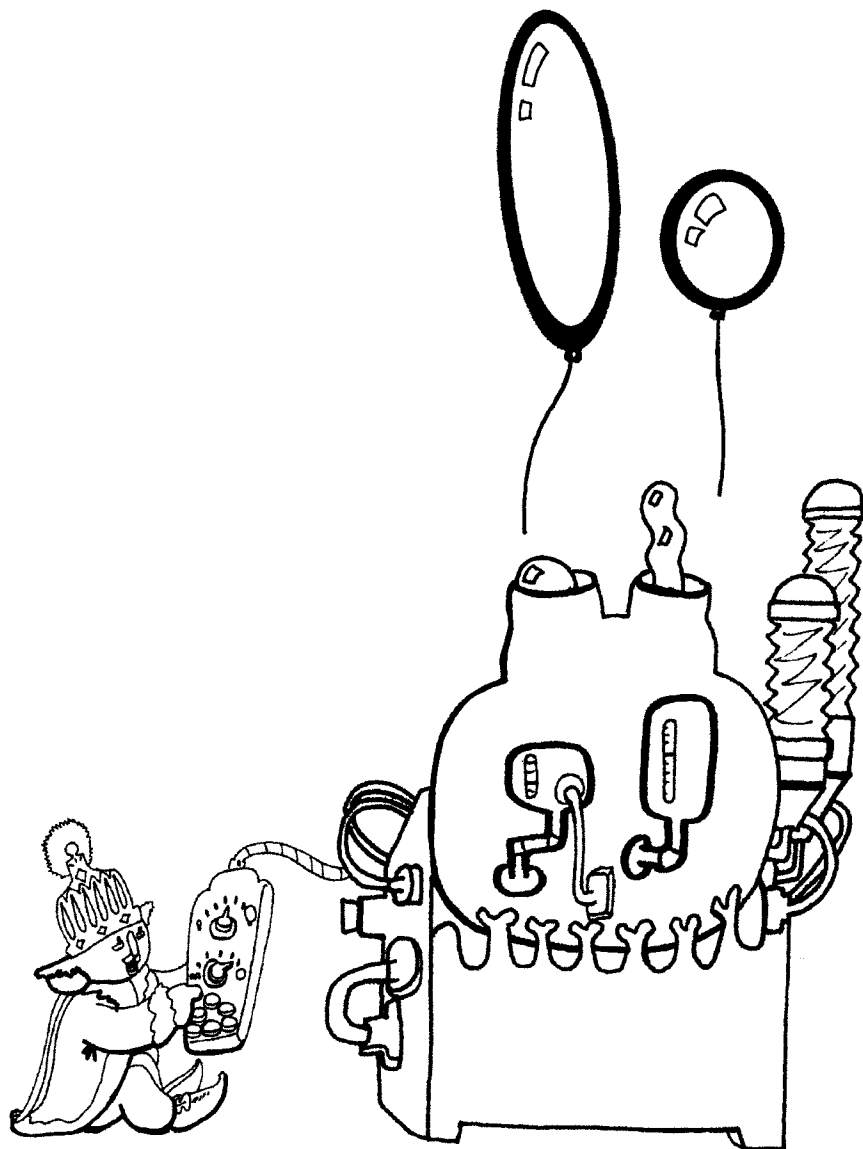
Design a Flag!

The king found the magic balloon machine! He can make any type of balloon he can think of. Do you think you can make more balloons than the king? Use pencils, crayons, or markers and have fun!

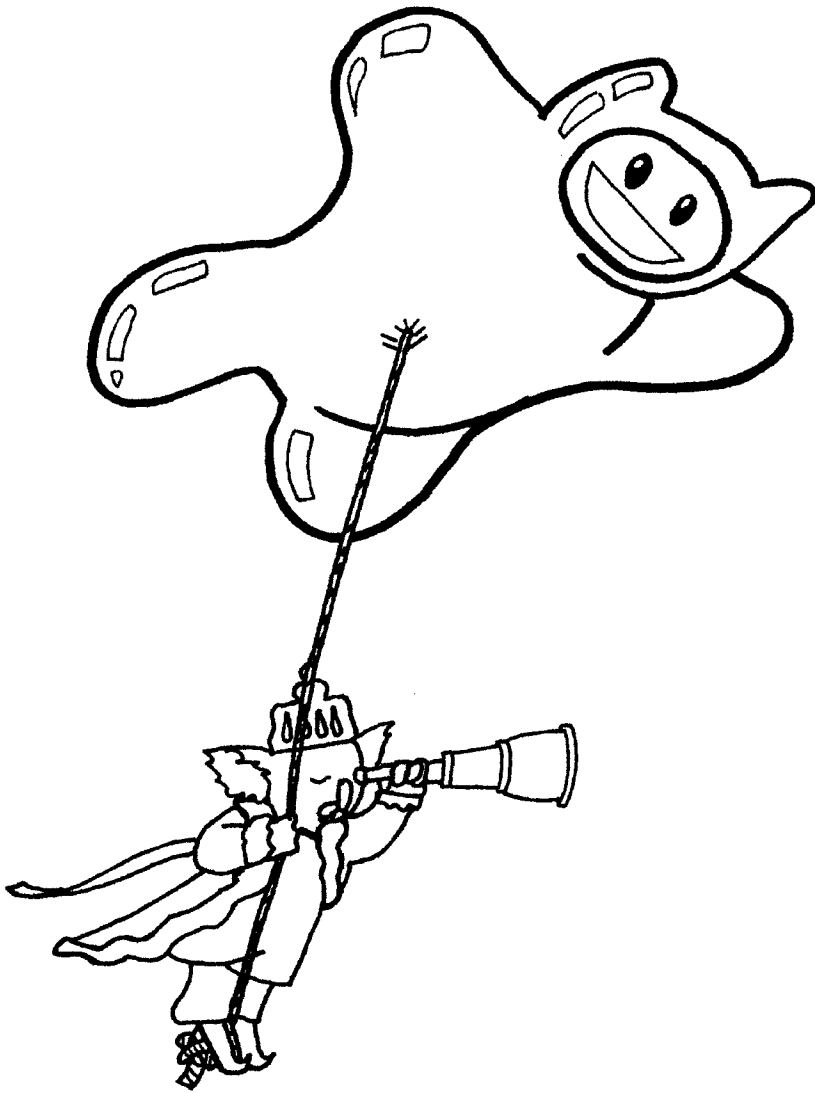

Let's play "I spy"!



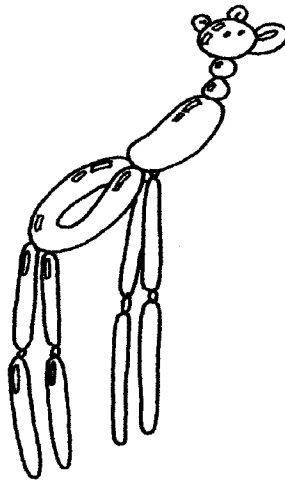

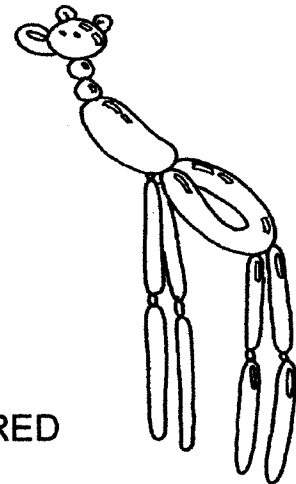
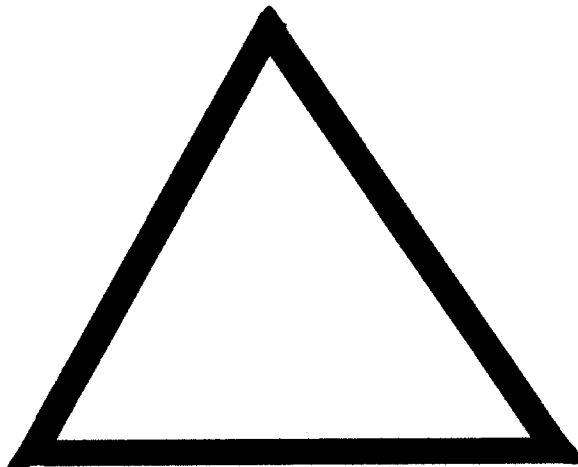

Help the Robot painter!

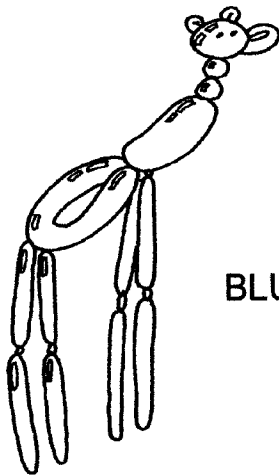

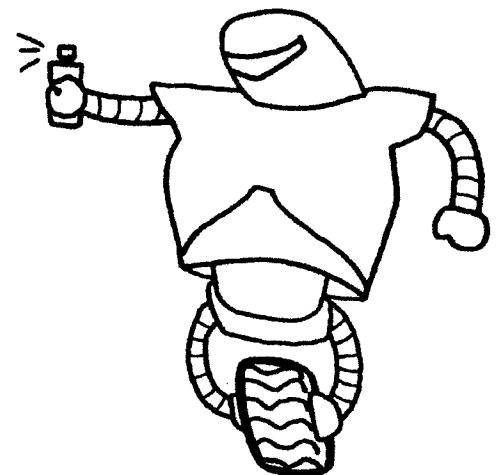

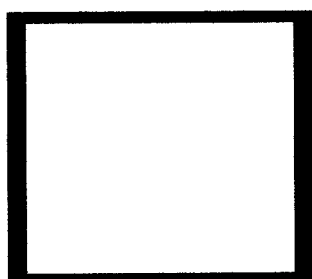
Beat the Shape-Making Robot!



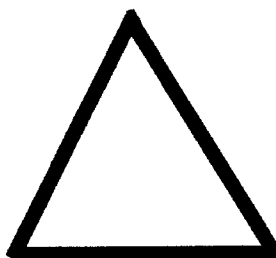
The Parade King is at it again! Now he is using his magic control to make a robot build shapes. Can you draw a Triangle, Square, and Circle, like the robot can?



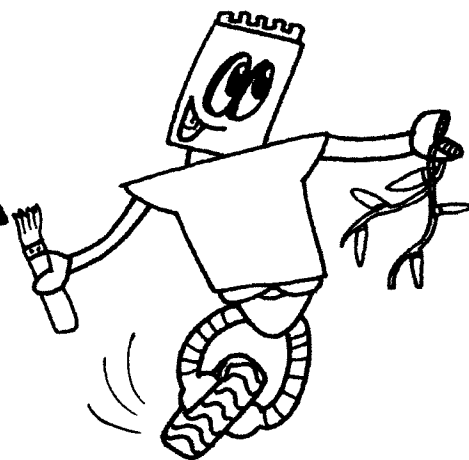

Square



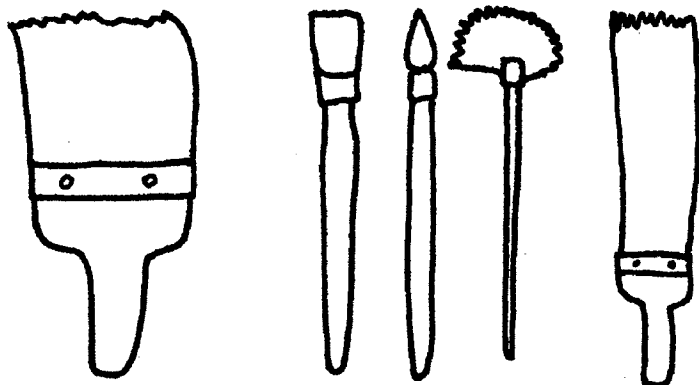

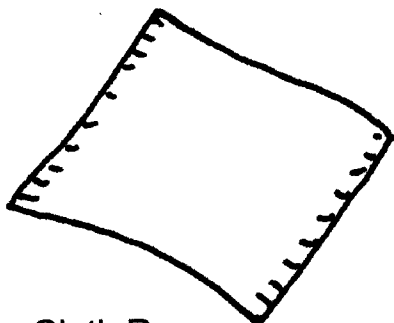

The parade needs your help to paint a sign. Take a look at all the tools you can use to paint!



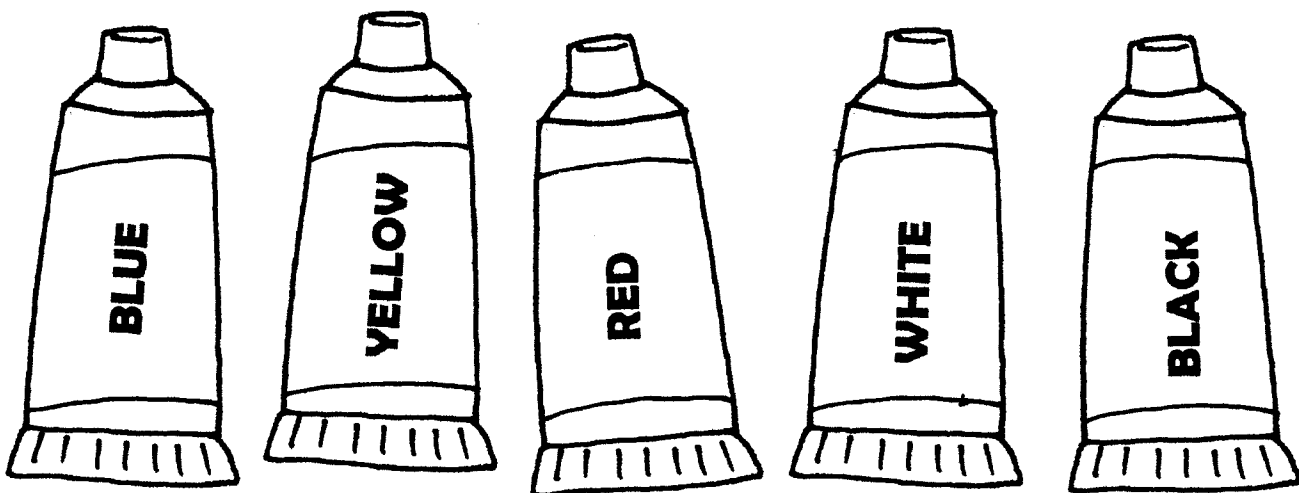

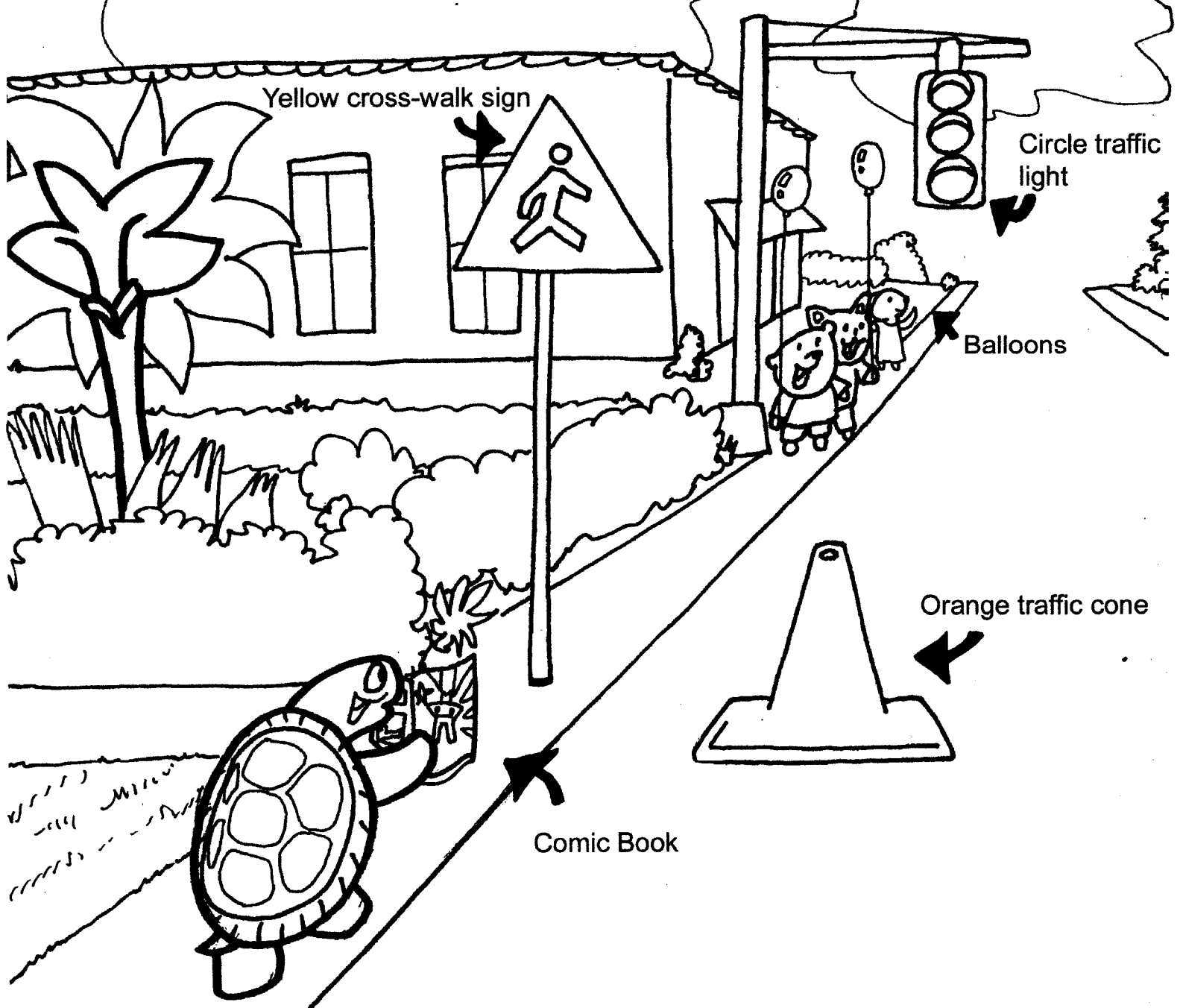
Let's Draw!

Explore art around you!

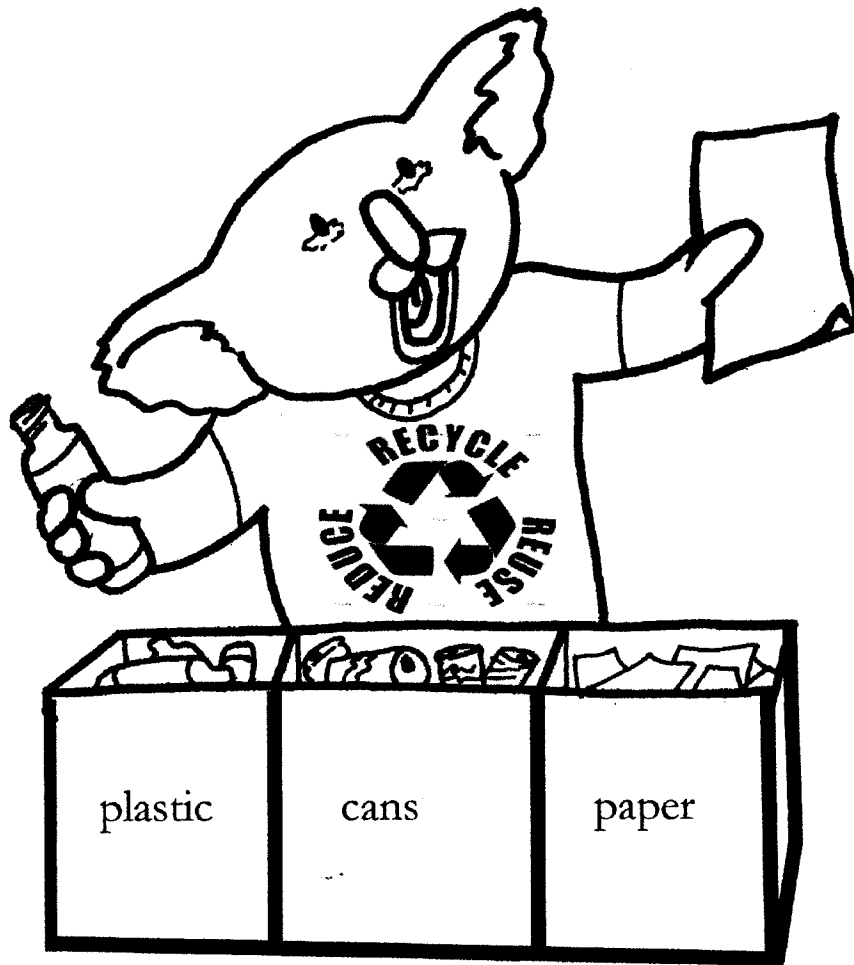
You can find art all around you. What shapes and drawings do you see here? What about when you look inside your classroom?
